

Manningham Council is proposing to rename the section of Henry Street that abuts Clancys Lane. It has become necessary to rename this relatively small section of road due to recent residential development on the abutting land.

The area impacted by the renaming is as follows:



The following name is proposed:

Bloom Street - The Bloom family were local fruit growers in the Doncaster area in the early to mid 1900's. The Street name 'Bloom' also creates a link to the Morrison Brothers Nursery that was situated opposite Henry Street for more than 30 years.
