Day/night works update

Site establishment, Avon Street, Bulleen.

We've started moving close to 100 above and underground services such as power, water, gas, sewer and telecommunications to make way for North East Link.

Since we last notified you about the Avon Street road closure at the intersection of Bulleen Road in Bulleen, the road closure date has changed to **Friday 9 April 2021.** This notification also includes updated working hours for night works at this location.

We apologise for this change to our planned works and for any inconvenience this may cause.

What we'll be doing

Works will include:

- Installation of temporary safety fencing, traffic barriers and lighting
- Removal of vegetation and kerbing
- Construction of a crushed rock base for the work area
- Implementing environmental controls such as tree protection, silt traps and dust suppression measures
- Construction of temporary laydown areas and infrastructure for the site
- Removal of the centre median strip on Bulleen Road
- Traffic management, pedestrian and cyclist detours on Bulleen Road during night works
- Construction of a receival shaft ready for the deployment of the mini Tunnel Boring Machine (TBM) in mid-2021
- Service investigations and service diversion works.

Long-term closure of Avon Street

- Concrete barriers will be placed along Bulleen Road to close the intersection. This will occur overnight on Friday 9 April 2021. A temporary speed reduction of 40kmh will be in place during these works.
- All lanes of traffic on Bulleen Road will be maintained after the closure
- Avon Street will be closed at the corner of Avon Street and Bulleen Road to create room for the work site
- Detours will be in place to access Avon Street from Austin Street and York Street
- The road closure and work site will be in place until late 2021.
 A new variable speed limit of 60 km/h and 40 km/h will be in place on Bulleen Road during this period.

When are we working?

7.30pm to **5.30am**, Sunday to Friday for night works from **Friday 9 April** until **Friday 21 May 2021**.

7am to **6pm**, Monday to Friday **7am** to **1pm**, Saturdays

From Monday 12 April until mid-2021.

Any work scheduled to occur outside these hours will only proceed after residents have been notified.

What to expect

During these works you may notice:

- · Work crews in the area
- Light from the work site
- Noise from machinery and equipment, such as an excavator, bobcat, generator and vehicles
- There will also be a crane to lift and place barriers
- Dust from the work site.

Managing impacts

CPB Contractors are committed to minimising construction impacts for residents and the community and will implement the following mitigation measures where appropriate:

Covering loads on trucks, when transporting excavated material and clean fill

- Directional lighting to avoid light spill
- Dust suppression using water carts and binding agents
- Noise control equipment and sound blankets may be used on machinery and tools
- Tree protection zones to retain as many trees as possible
- Pedestrian and cyclist detours will be in place around the work site.


Our community engagement team will be onsite and available to assist residents during the works.
